## Overview

- ✓ Your primary responsibility is to promote the safeguarding and welfare of the children in our care.
- ✓ Do what is needed to keep campers happy, healthy and wanting to return for more.
- ✓ Typically you will be one of three 'Leaders' in a group of 24 campers, one of which is in charge ('<u>Group</u> <u>Leader</u>').

## Responsibilities

#### Training

✓ Complete our full training programme and implement effectively all policies and procedures.

#### Activities

✓ Plan and deliver quality, fun and safe activities (e.g. sports, arts & crafts, songs, messy play).

#### **Pastoral Care**

✓ Build a good rapport with the campers and parents, monitoring and responding to any pastoral needs.

#### **Behaviour Management**

✓ Address campers' behavioural / emotional issues, liaise with your Group Leader and be proactive.

#### Health, Hygiene & Safety

✓ Monitor, assess and promote a healthy and safe camp (e.g. regular toilet runs and hand washing).

## **Early Years Foundation Stage**

✓ With our guidance and training, for campers aged 5 and under, you must have regard for how the EYFS can be incorporated into your timetable.

#### Lates

✓ Once a week help care for and run activities for campers who have booked an extended/late stay.

## **Other Duties**

✓ When required this may include: changing age groups, break supervision and being the Lion mascot.

## Paperwork

✓ Assist in ensuring that forms such as Risk Assessments and Planning Sheets are completed correctly.
