Training

'Sport' Leaders

'Cookery' Leaders

- Deliver an elective activities, including developing skills in baking and pasta making.

'Adventure' Leaders

- Independently run & support external instructors during pre-planned AM elective activities.

Afternoon Activities

- ✓ Deliver a variety of quality, fun and safe activities (from wet 'n' wild to tie-dying).

Daily Routine

- ✓ Support the pastoral team by assisting with daily tasks such as meal supervision, wake up and lights out.

Pastoral Support
