- ✓ Monitor, assess and promote a healthy and safe camp.

 - Independently deliver fun & safe specialist elective activities.
- ✓ **'Multi Activity' Leaders**
 - Independently deliver a variety of fun & safe activities.

Afternoon & Evening Activities

Duty
