Other Activities

- ✓ Assist staff in delivering other activities for 3 – 12 year olds.

Pastoral Childcare

- ✓ Build a good rapport with the campers, monitor and respond to any pastoral/safeguarding needs.

Behaviour Management

- ✓ Address campers' behavioural / emotional issues, liaise with Supervisors and be proactive.

Health, Hygiene & Safety

- ✓ Monitor, assess and promote a healthy and safe camp (e.g. regular toilet runs and hand washing).

Early Years Foundation Stage

- ✓ With our guidance and training, for campers aged 5 and under, you must have regard for how the EYFS can be incorporated into your timetable.

Lates

- ✓ Once a week help care for and run activities for campers who have booked an extended/late stay.

Other Duties

- ✓ Helping in different age groups, break supervision, welcoming and being the Lion mascot.

Paperwork

- ✓ Ensure that forms such as Risk Assessments and Planning Sheets are completed correctly.
