# **Overview**

✓ Your primary responsibility is to promote the safeguarding and welfare of the children in our care.

- ✓ Do what is needed to keep campers happy, healthy and wanting to return for more.
- ✓ Typically, there will be three playworkers in a group of 24 campers, with you being in charge.

# Responsibilities

### **Training**

✓ Complete our full training programme and implement effectively all policies and procedures.

#### **Activities**

- ✓ Lead planning and delivery of quality, fun and safe activities (e.g. sports, arts & crafts, songs, messy play).
- ✓ If you specialise in an activity (eg: sport, dance, drama) you will spend time in different groups with different campers, running specialised sessions & playing to your strengths.

#### **Pastoral Childcare**

Manage your group's (children & staff) pastoral needs, discussing issues with parents when necessary.

### **Behaviour Management**

Oversee your group's behavioural/emotional issues, liaise with your Age Group Manager and be proactive.

### Health, Hygiene & Safety

✓ Monitor, assess and promote a healthy and safe camp (e.g. regular toilet runs and hand washing).

## Early Years Foundation Stage (ages 3, 4 & 5)

✓ You must have regard for how the EYFS can be incorporated into your timetable.

#### Lates

Once a week help run activities and care for campers who have booked an extended/late stay.

### **Other Duties**

✓ When required this may include: changing age groups, break supervision, managing equipment & closely communicate with Age Group Manager.

#### **Paperwork**

✓ Take charge in ensuring forms such as Accident / Incident Forms, Risk Assessments and Planning Sheets are completed correctly & signed.
